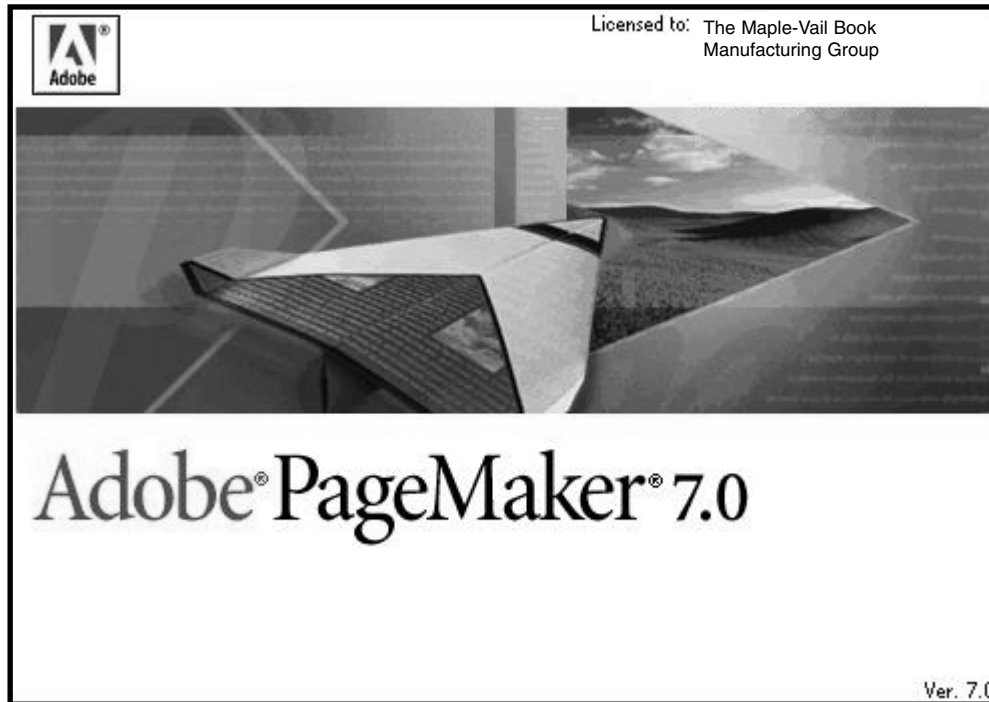


PostScripting Instructions for Two-Color Work

Adobe 7 PageMaker



Setting and Preferences

Note that the screen captures for PageMaker 6.5 are identical to those of PageMaker 7.0.

Use these instructions to write PostScript from PageMaker. You will then be able to create PDFs from the PostScript by using Acrobat Distiller.

Separate instructions are available on the *maple-vail.com* web site for distilling PDF files.



Document Setup settings:

- Select *Page size*: Custom
- Select *Target output resolution*: 2540 dpi

Document Setup

Dimensions: **6** by **9** inches

Orientation: Tall Wide

Options: Double-sided Adjust layout
 Facing pages Restart page numbering

Number of pages: **1** Start page #: **1**

Margins

Inside	1 inches	Outside	0.75 inches

Target output resolution: **2540** dpi

Document settings:

- Select *PPD*: Color General
- Select *Pages*: All
- Select *Print Blank Pages*
- Select *Orientation*: Portrait (Left icon)

Print Document

Printer: LaserWriter Pro 630

PPD: **Color General** Collate Reverse Proof

Copies: **1**

Pages: All Ranges Reader's spreads Ignore "Non-Printing" setting Print blank pages

Print: **Both Pages**

Book: Print all publications in book Use paper settings of each publication

Orientation: Portrait Landscape

Paper settings:

- Select *Size*: Custom Paper
(Add 1.5 inches to document trim width and height amounts, then enter total in the Custom Paper Size dialog box: i.e., if your document is 6 x 9, enter 7.5 x 10.5)
- Select *Printer's marks*
- Select *Crops and bleeds only*
- Select *Page information*
- Select *Center page in print area*
- Select *Tiling*: None
- Select *Scale*: Type 100%

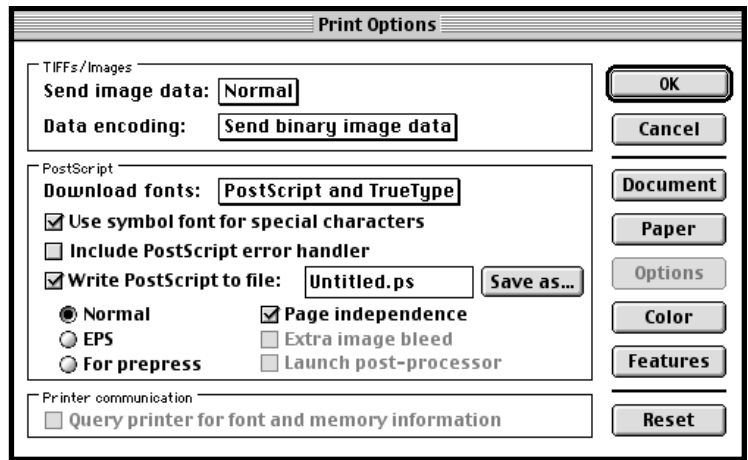

Options settings:

- Select *Send image data*: Normal
- Select *Data encoding*: Send binary image data
- Select *Download fonts*: PostScript and True Type
- Select *Use symbol font for special characters*
- Select *Write PostScript to file*: Type a logical name
- Select *Normal*
- Select *Page Independence*
- Select *Save as*: (Type in a logical name and location for the PostScript file)



Color settings:

- Select *Composite*
- Select *Color*
- Select *Optimized screen*: Custom
- Select *Frequency*: 133 lpi
- Select *Angle*: 45
