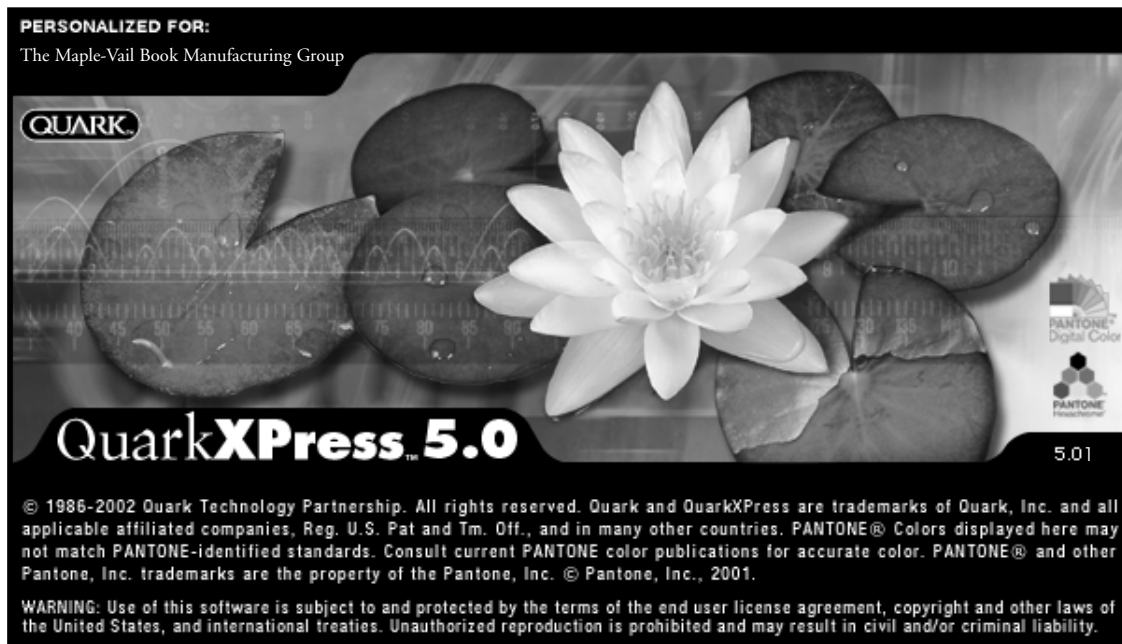


PostScripting Instructions for Two-Color Work

Setting and Preferences

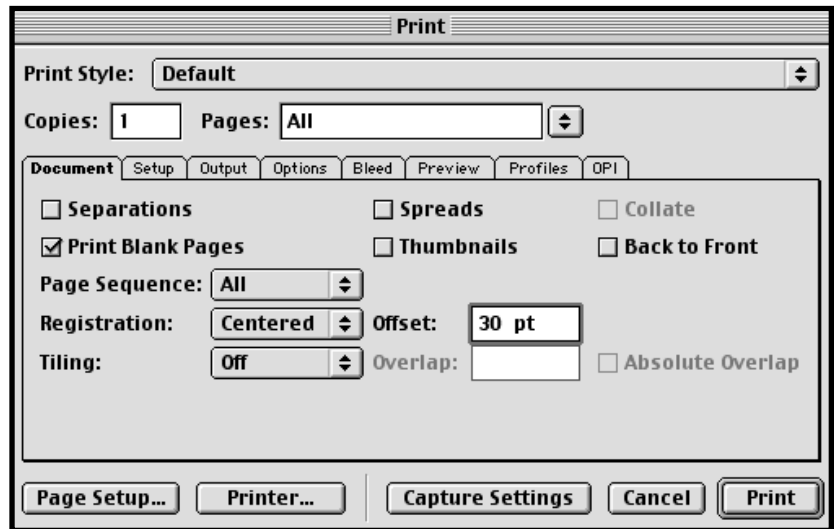
Use these instructions to write PostScript from QuarkXPress 5.01. You will then be able to create PDFs from the PostScript by using Acrobat Distiller.

Separate instructions are available on the *maple-vail.com* web site for distilling PDF files.



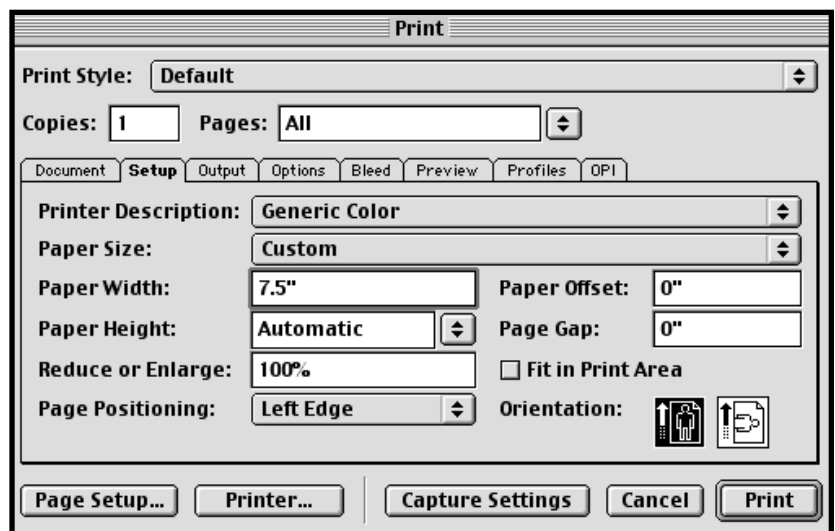
Document Tab:

- Select *Print Blank Pages*
- Select *Page Sequence*: All
- Select *Registration*: Centered
- Select *Offset*: 30 pt
- Select *Tiling*: Off



Setup Tab:

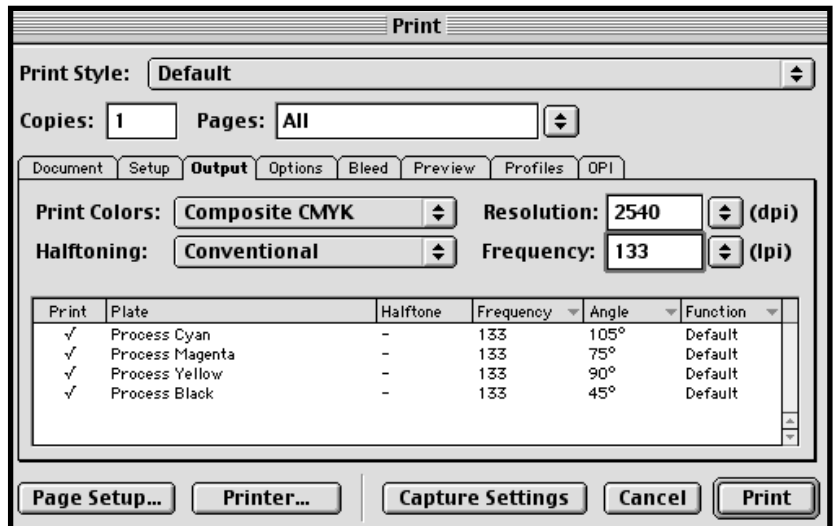
- Select *Printer Description*: Generic Color
- Select *Paper Size*: Custom
- Select *Paper Width*: (Trim size + 1.5 inches)
- Select *Paper Offset*: 0 inches
- Select *Paper Height*: Automatic
- Select *Page Gap*: 0 inches
- Select *Reduce or Enlarge*: 100%
- Select *Page Positioning*: Left Edge or Centered
- Select *Orientation*: Portrait (Left icon)



Output Tab:

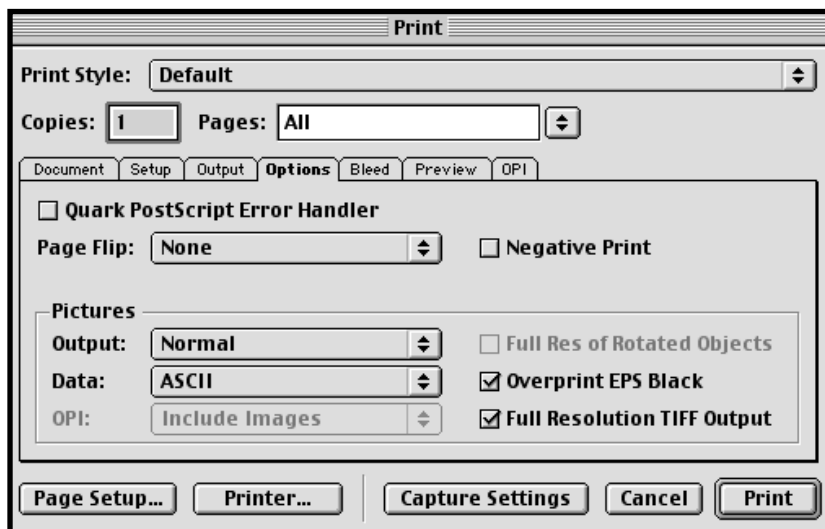
• Select *Print Colors*: Composite CMYK
Note: If your job has Pantone colors specified, select *Separations* in the *Document* tab. Then, under the *Output* tab, select *Used Process & Spot* and select the colors to print.

- Select *Resolution*: 2540 dpi
- Select *Halftoning*: Conventional
- Select *Frequency*: 133 lpi



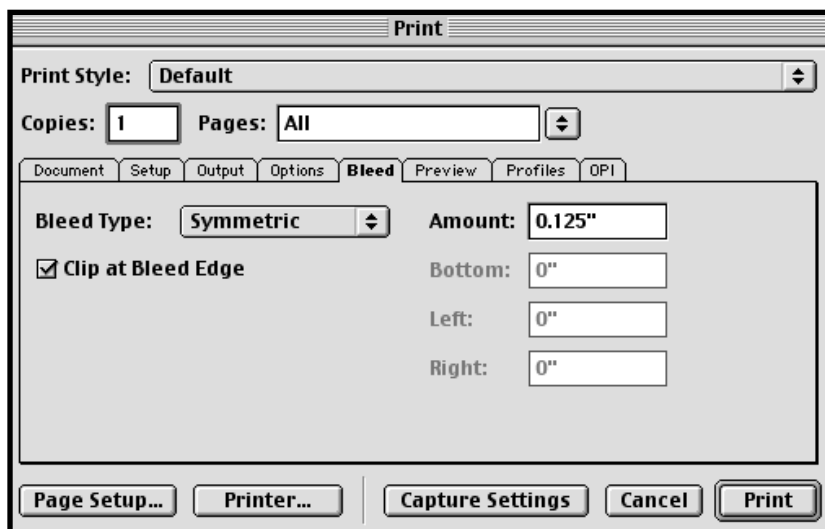
Options Tab:

- Select *Page Flip*: None
- Select *Output*: Normal
- Select *Data*: Binary or ASCII
- Select *Full Resolution TIFF Output*



Bleed Tab:

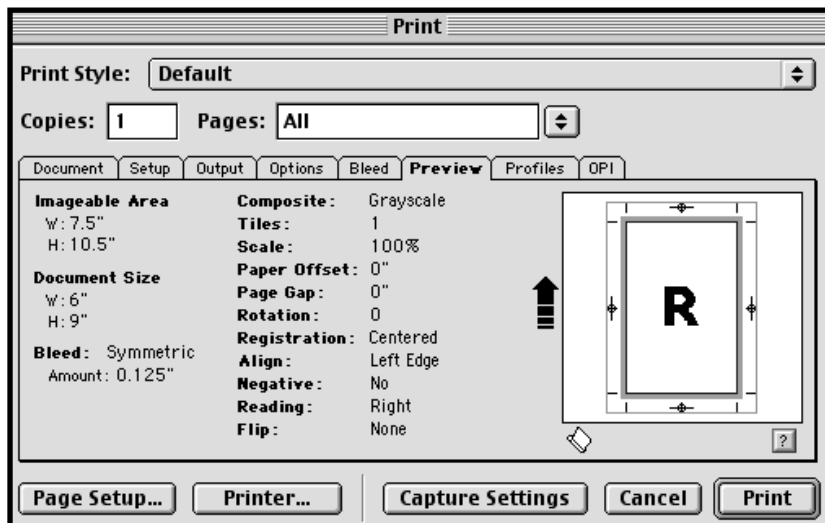
- Select *Bleed Type*: Symmetric
- Select *Amount*: 0.125 inches
- Select *Clip at Bleed Edge*



Preview Tab:

No adjustments needed in this area

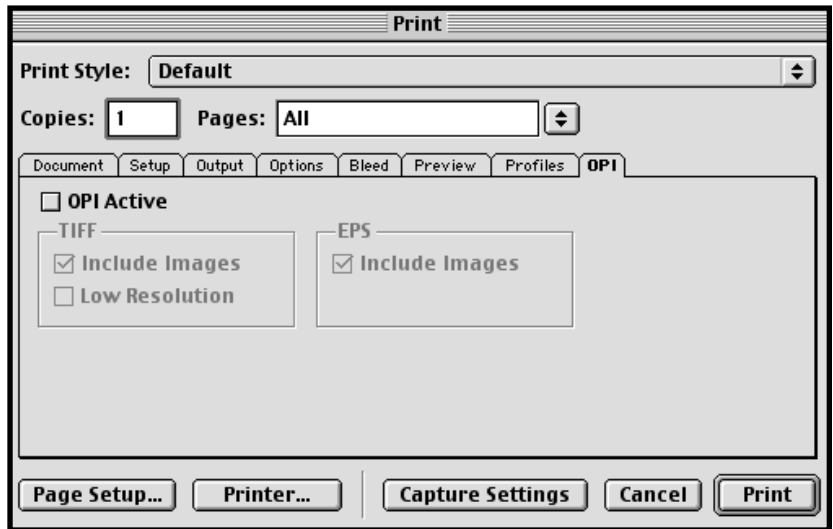
Review settings and thumbnail to ensure that specifications are correct



OPI Tab:

No selections are needed in this area

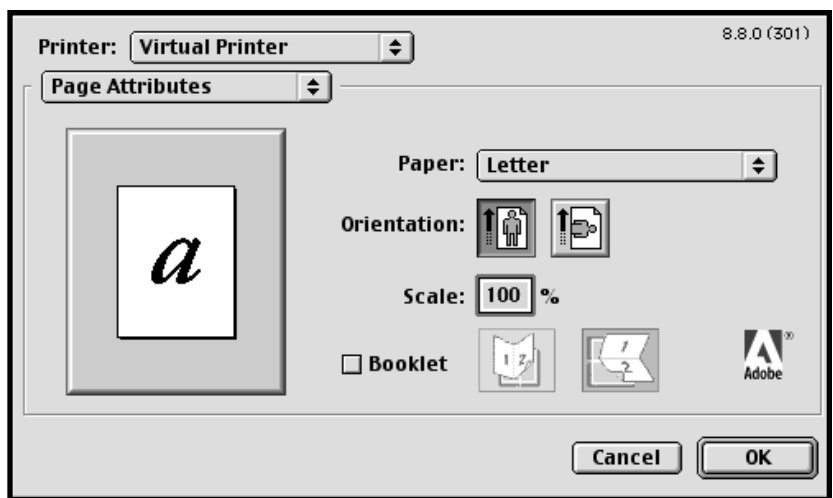
Click the *Page Setup* button



Page Attributes:

Choose *Page Attributes* from Pulldown Menu

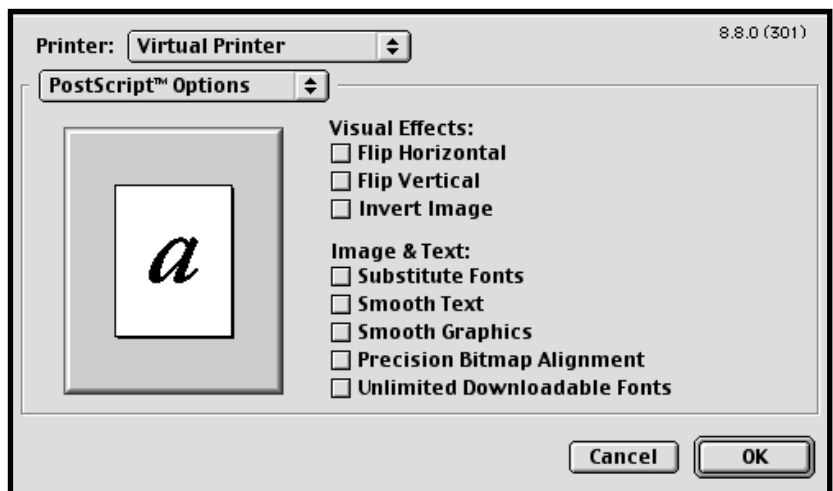
- Select *Paper*: Letter
- Select *Orientation*: Portrait (Left icon)
- Select *Scale*: Type 100%



PostScript Options settings:

Choose *PostScript Options* from Pulldown Menu

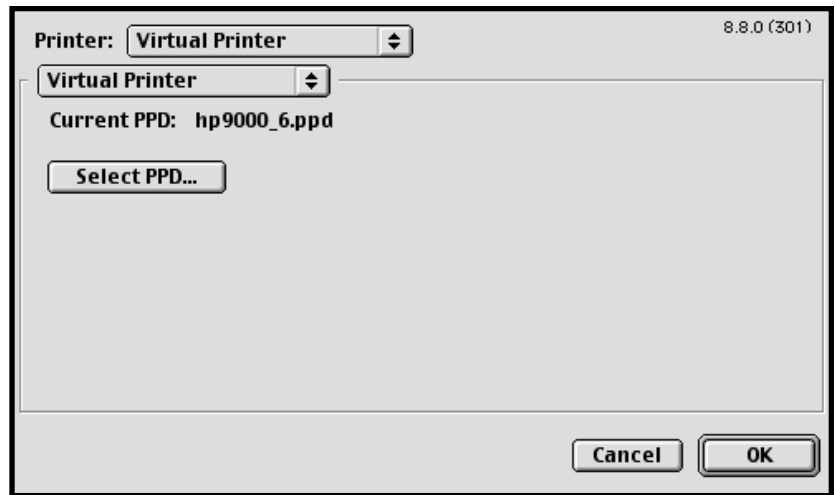
- No selections are needed



Virtual Printer settings:

Choose *Virtual Printer* from Pulldown Menu
(Select an appropriate PPD the first time using the *Select PPD* button)

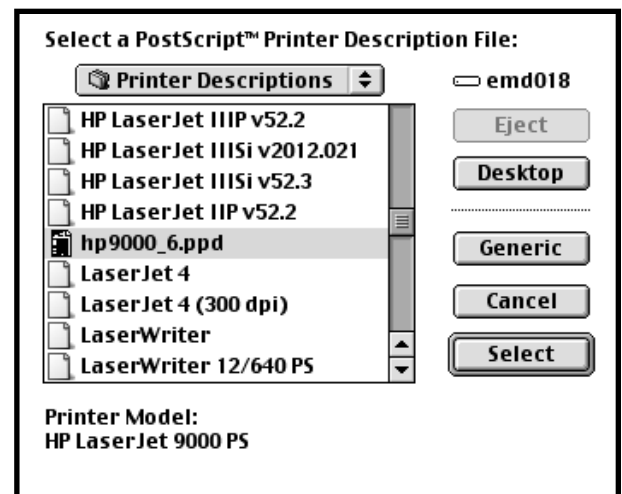
- Current PPD: hp 9000_6.ppd



Printer Descriptions settings:

Choose *Printer Descriptions* from Pulldown Menu
Go to the Printer Descriptions folder located in your systems
Extension folder.

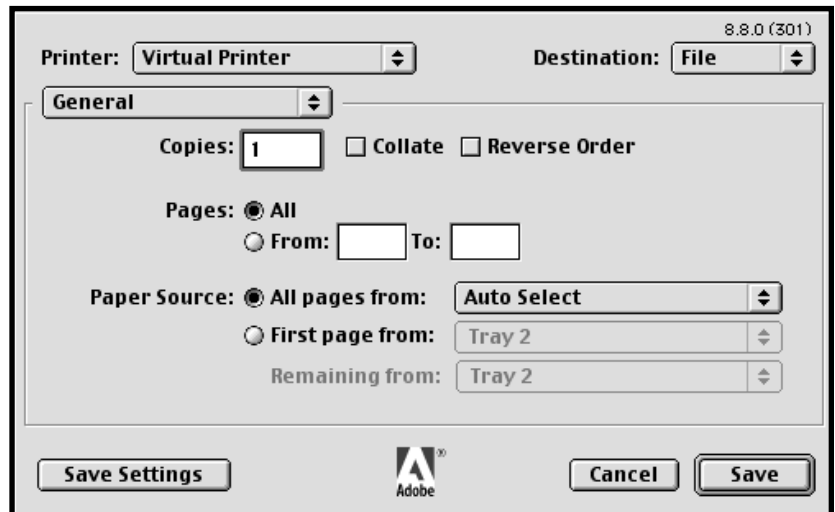
- Select the recommended HP 9000 PPD or another quality high output PPD
- Click *Select*



General settings:

Choose *General* from Pulldown Menu

- Select *Copies*: 1
- Select *Pages*: All
- Select *Paper Source*: All pages from: Use the pulldown menu to choose a dedicated tray



Background Printing settings:

Choose *Background Printing* from Pulldown Menu

- Select *Print in:* Background
- Select *Print Time:* Normal

Choose *Color Matching* from Pulldown Menu

- Select *Print Color:* Color/Grayscale

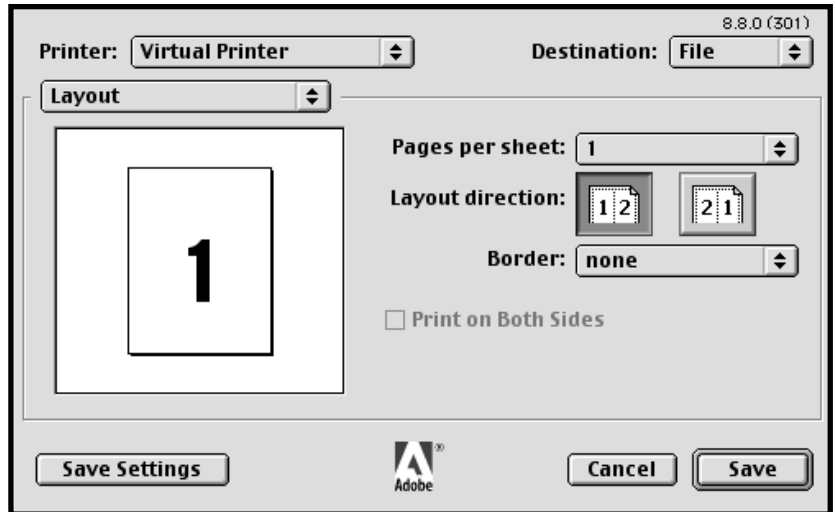

Layout settings:

Choose *Layout* from Pulldown Menu

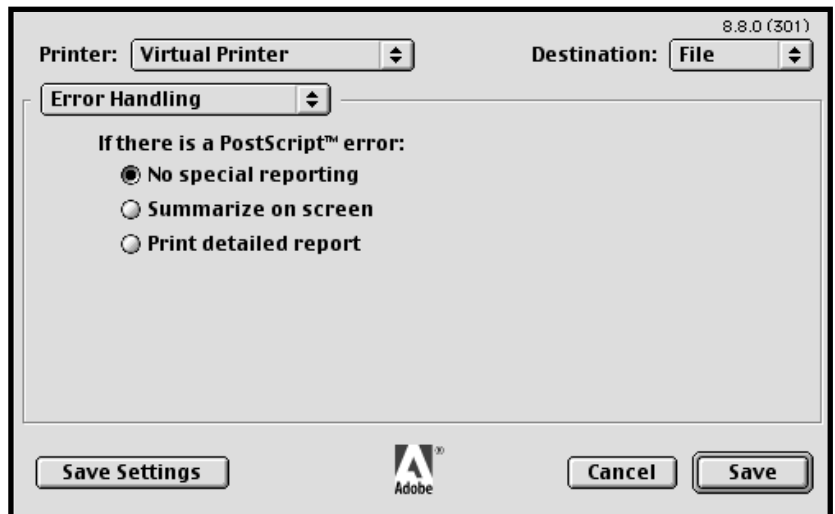
- Select *Pages per sheet*: 1
- Select *Layout Direction*: Left icon
- Select *Border*: none



Error Handling settings:

Choose *Error Handling* from Pulldown Menu

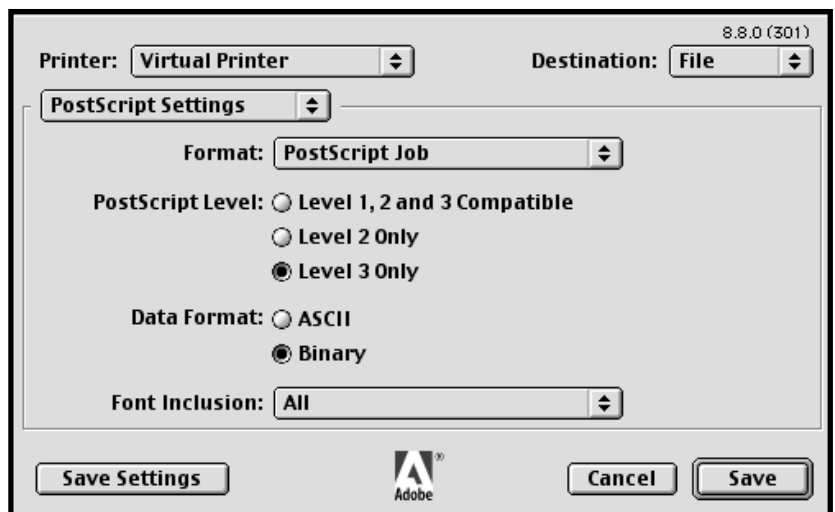
- Select *If there is a PostScript error*: No special reporting



PostScript Settings:

Choose *PostScript Settings* from Pulldown Menu

- Select *Format*: PostScript Job
- Select *PostScript Level*: Level 3 only
- Select *Data Format*: Binary
- Select *Font Inclusion*: All
- Click *Save*



Saving File Window:

- Type in a logical name for the PostScript file
- Click *Save* and then *Print*
